

## Fall Services and Products

Fall will be here shortly and the demand for pool closings will be heavy. Therefore, we urge you to call and schedule your closing as soon as possible to ensure that you can be winterized and closed at your convenience. Our closing crew is available Monday through Saturday and we are typically in each town at least once a week. Unfortunately we are unable to give a time of arrival as some closings require a longer or shorter stay than others. Please bear with us as weather and other unforeseen factors sometimes require a reschedule or change.

**The Following needs to be done prior to our arrival in order to complete both closing options:**

- Place winter cover, winter freeze-out plugs, gizzmos (in-ground pools only) and water tubes (if used) by pool. **NOTE: Anything not left out will be provided by Snyder Pools and billed out accordingly. If the winter cover is not left out at time of closing a return trip will be an additional charge.**
- If there is a timer on the pool please make us aware prior to the closing. If the timer is not turned off properly the pump may turn back on after the pool has been winterized. The Customer is held responsible for turning off the circuit breaker and/or disabling timer after we have winterized the pool.
- All Drop-in steps need to be removed prior to closing; we do NOT remove them at closings.
- For all inground pools not installed by Snyder Pools, the water level must be lowered below the skimmers.
- Pool closings Do Not Include removal of leaves or debris. We now offer a separate cleaning service that would be done prior to closing. (See Fall Clean Up Contract)
- Due to possible algae growth often associated with safety covers we recommend that you super chlorinate your pool with 1lb per 10,000 gallons of Super Shock prior to your scheduled closing. We also recommend an algaecide be poured through the cover in late Fall and again in early Spring.
- All pools not installed by Snyder Pools will incur an additional \$25 charge to blow out lines.

**Option # 1** – Pool closing includes the following:

- Installation of the winter cover or Pacific Safety Cover/Loop Loc Cover
- Complete draining of filtration system
- Removal of ladders and accessories
- Installing your freeze-out plugs and gizzmos in pool fittings
- Addition of Shock and Algaecide

**Please Note:**

- Customers who use the Sustain Program will be charged an additional \$20 for Winter Shield. (Retail for \$41.44)
- All closings are a prepaid option; we can not accept payment at the time of service. The closing must be prepaid or the service will not be performed as scheduled.
- We advise that prior to winterizing your pool you keep the filter operating normally and maintain proper chlorine and balancing chemical reading. (Chlorine 1-3ppm; pH 7.2-7.6; Alkalinity 80-120ppm; Cyanuric Acid 50-80ppm & 80-90ppm for salt generators).
- Water should be siphoned off covers during the fall and spring months to minimize the weight pulling on the cover. You must replenish the pool water under the cover, keeping it at its normal winter level. Failure to do so may compromise the integrity of the cover and pool structure.

**IMPORTANT:** Due to unforeseen weather conditions, and situations beyond Snyder Pools control, Snyder Pools cannot be responsible or liable for damages done to pool or plumbing due to winter damage or freeze up.

**IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO ABOVEGROUND OWNERS:** Due to the potential snowfall in the winter season, there has been an increase in the number of pools collapsing caused by snow and ice build-up, expansion of ice shifting, etc. this type of collapse does not fall under any warranty situation. Please do all you can to prevent your pool from collapsing. **No gizzmos or plugs** should be placed in either the inlet or skimmer. Leave both lines open to allow drainage of water. Pay special attention to removing snow and water build-up off cover. Always keep cover loose, not taut. If you need assistance during the winter, our service crew is available to respond.
